THE Officers and Teachers of Knox Church Sunday School, in presenting their annual statement, are glad to report the continued prosperity of the school during the year 1895.

Both in attendance and finances the report will show an increase over the year 1894. The aggregate attendance of the school was 15,298, an average of 306, as against 202 in 1804.

This average was made up as follows:—Bible Class, 63; School Proper, 145; Primary Class, 65; Teachers, 26; Officers, 7.

The school was open every Sunday of the year.

The Bible Class, under Mr. Malcolm, met 40 Sundays. The average attendance, 63, was larger than in any previous year.
