PARKHILL, WILLIAM J., J.P., (*South Simcoe.*)

B. in Co. Tyrone, Irel., 27 Nov. 1839. Ed. there. Came to Canada, 25 June, 1856. M. Miss Crossley, dau. of N.P. Crossley, Esq., of King, Ont., 30 Oct. 1862. Is Grand Master of the Loyal Orange Lodge of Ontario West, and D.G. Master of the Grand Lodge of B.A., and D.G. Master of Royal Black of B.A. Was Deputy Reeve of Mulmur for the years 1874-75 and elected Reeve in 1876, each time by acclamation. Presdt. of the Mulmur branch of the Conservative Asso. First returned to Parl., for present seat, 29 Oct., 1878, on the resignation of Hon. Wm. McDougall, C.B. Re-elected at last g.e. A Liberal Conservative, and opposed to the present Government.—*Randwich P.O., Ont.*

PATTERSON, PETER. (*West York.*)

Ancestors came from Co. Antrim, Irel., to New Hampshire in Am., 1736. There many members of the family subsequently distinguished themselves in the service of the country as judges, legislators and governors. S. of the late Col. Robert Patterson, of Perry, N.Y., a mem. of the Leg. of New Hampshire, and subsequently of that of New York. B. in Londonderry, N.H., 10 April, 1835. Ed. at Huntington Academy, Perry. Came to York, Canada, 1849. M., Sept. 1859, Miss K. E. Haffy, of Yonge Street. An agricultural implement manufacturer. Was Reeve of Vaughan from 1868 to 1871, when elected Warden of the Co. First returned to Parl. at g.e. 1871; re-elected by acclamation at g.e. 1875, and again returned at last g.e. A Liberal, and supporter of Mr. Mowat.—*Patterson, Ont.*

PECK, SAMUEL STANLEY. (*North Victoria.*)

S. of James Peck, who is a grandson of James Peck, one of the U.E. Loyalists, who settled in the Co. of Prince Edward in the year 1800, having previously resided some time in N.S. B. Township of Amherstburg, Co. Prince Edward, Nov. 20, 1829. Ed. at Common School there. M., 1st, Sarah Ann, dau. of Richard Harder, Esq., of the Township of Sidney, Co. Hastings, 17 July 1857; (she d. 1 Nov. 1875); 2nd, Susan dau. of William Vandervoot, of Sidney, Co. Hastings, 19 Dec. 1876. Was Reeve 15 years.
