

An Act to amend the Laws relating to Militia Pensions
in Upper Canada.

WHEREAS it is desirable that all Militia men entitled to Pensions for Preamble.
services rendered during the late War in Upper Canada, should
have and enjoy all the same claims and rights with respect to all arrears of
such Pensions as are, by the laws of Lower Canada, conferred upon Militia
5 Pensioners in that section of the Province; Therefore Her Majesty, &c.,
enacts as follows:

All Militia Pensioners at present receiving or entitled to receive Pen-
sions for services rendered during the late War shall, as regards any claims Laws of U. C.

in certain res-
pects.
for any arrears of such Pension that may be due to them, be placed on the
same footing with respect thereto, as Militia Pensioners under the laws of
10 Lower Canada; and any law or act of Upper Canada relating to such Pen-
sions shall, so far as regards the said arrears, be assimilated to the said
laws of Lower Canada in that behalf.
