Mode of appointing the Commissioners.

meeting of the Common Council of the said City of Toronto, after the said By-law shall have been passed, it shall be the duty of the Mayor of the said City for the time being to submit to the Council the names of three persons to be appointed the Water Commissioners for the said city, and the said Common Council shall forthwith proceed to confirm or reject such nomination; and if the said Council shall not confirm such persons in the said appointment, but shall reject them, or any of them, the Mayor shall forthwith nominate another or others and submit the same to the said Council, until three persons named by him for the said office shall have been confirmed therein by the said Council.

Terms of office of the Commissioners.

XX. The said Water Commissioners shall at their first meeting after their nomination and confirmation in the said office as aforesaid, determine by lot or otherwise, the terms during which they shall respectively hold their offices, and these shall be as follows: one of them shall remain in office one year, one two years, and one three years, to be computed 15 from the time of their confirmation in the said office by the said Council; and as their terms of office severally expire, or vacancies may occur by death, resignation or removal from the city or otherwise, it shall be the duty of the Mayor for the time being to nominate a person or persons to fill such vacancy or vacancies and for the said Common Council to 20 confirm the same in manner aforesaid: Provided always, that any retiring member of the said Board shall be eligible for re-appointment; and further, that it shall at all times be competent for the Common Council of the said City of Toronto to remove the said Water Commissioners or any or either of them from office by a vote of two-thirds of the members 25 of the said Common Council.

Remuneration of Commissioners.

XXI. The Chairman of the said Commissioners and the said Commissioners shall be paid for their services by an annual vote of the said Common Council, and shall also be paid all reasonable travelling expenses while employed upon or about the work.

XXII. This Act shall be deemed and taken as a public Act.
