Reserve. The Chief appears to be favourable to
surround all that portion on the east of the Bird Tail
River, as he states it is not used by any member of
his band, and if of more value than the land
set apart for them for a fishing station he requested
me to ask you if you would not supply them
with some wagons to make up the difference in
value and I promised to forward his request to
you.
