It cannot fail to give me much a satisfaction to find my conduct approved by my dupperiors, especially a Person of so high Rank and bon spicuous a Character as your Excellency, even for so a doing no more than my duty, in which I shall a steadily persevere without the smallest deviation from your Orders and Instructions. It is no small comfort and incouragement to be well supported; and I can apure your Excellency it is absolutely necessary."

M. Elliott has of late convected - himself by giving in a false Return of the Indians at Chenail Ecarte settlement he makes them 543 which exceeds by about 360 the number that any other can make them?

Thave inclosed to baptain Green a Return of these Indians which I am convinced is as accurate as possible, thaving written to him so fully on this and every other subject within my observation, that I shall forbear troubling you unnecessarily."

"Since writing the above I have received a Letter from M. Selby Indian Secretary, by desire of Mr. M. Kee , acquainting me that as the Indians of hinail Carte are all going out a Hunting, sending provisions
