I attach copy of a letter received here some little time ago from our Agent at Duck Lake, Sask., Mr. G. P. Schmidt, in which he deals with the subject of a grazing permit on the old Dundurn Forest Reserve for members of the White Cap Sioux Band, residing on the Moose Woods Reserve.

You will note that the statement is made that certain of the lands over which grazing privileges are desired are now under the control of your Department, and if so I should like to know whether grazing rights might be granted to the Indians of the White Cap Sioux Band for a reasonable period, as requested. Information submitted in this connection in due course would be appreciated.
