Dear Arthur:

I thought you might be interested in this year's Report of the Committee on Labor Law of the New York State Bar Association. Within the next week or so a bill will be introduced in the New York State Legislature for the regulation of labor unions. The bill incorporates the proposals made last year by the Committee and is sponsored by the State Bar Association. I am not too hopeful that it will be passed at this session because the American public, even now, is not sufficiently aware of the abuse of power by labor union leaders. However, it is, as far as I know, the first bill of its kind, and, as a pioneer effort, it may pave the way for sensible regulation of labor unions in the public interest.
