 a supply of medicines to the
 Industrial school with full
 instructions as to their use,
 and as the Sisters connected
 with the Institution are
 somewhat expert in attend-
 -ing on the sick, he does not
 see the necessity for appointing
 a Doctor for the school; nor
 does he consider it necessary
 to have a regular Medical
 Attendant for the Indians on
 the Reserves above named,
 where a complete supply of medi-
 -cines are also kept and the
 Agents have instructions as
 their use.

Mr. Lewdney, however,
 states that, in the event of your
 removing
