



Ottawa, May 3, 1907.

Sir : -

I am directed to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo, No. 37/3, and to inform you that Mr. Inspector Graham was instructed on the 1st instant that when he goes down to Moose Mountain to take charge of the Treaty payments he should report as to whether Mr. Stewart is capable of performing the duties assigned to him, and, in the meantime if he considers it necessary, he should send his clerk once a month to inspect the office work. It is considered, therefore, inadvisable at present to make any change until the Inspector is heard from in the matter.
