Gentlemen:-

With reference to your letter of Aug. 7, last, I beg to inform you that Mr. W. P. Wright, Indian Agent, Fort Frances, has reported that the work done to protect the bank of the Indian Reserve at the front of the Boarding School and at Reserve No. 16A last fall is not of a permanent nature and is of no use as it will all wash away in the spring. I have to request that substantial and satisfactory works be immediately undertaken by the Ontario, Minnesota Power Company to protect the bank in question and if such satisfactory works are not executed by the said Company in the near future proceedings will be taken in Exchequer Court in accordance with the advice.

This Department has received from the Department of Justice.
