Sir.

Referring to your letter \$75. Y. dated 25th.

April 1891 touching the application of the Sushwap and Okanagan Railway Co, for right of way through the Spalumcheen and Okanagen Indian Reserves: I have the honor to submit the following my report thereon: I right ofway through the Spallumcheen Reserve.

The line of Railway running through
this reserve fellows the general direction of the
Slough and water course which form the eastern
boundary of this reserve; the land taken is mostly
heavily timbered and somewhat broken, it consists
mostly of a rich leam which would be very productive if cleared and brought under cultivation.
The cost of clearing would be heavy. The acreage
appears to aggee with the Book of Reference which
you sent to me under cover of our letter where it
is referred to under items 8.71-5.91 and 8.64
making a total of 25.26 acres. I consider this
land to be worth \$25.00 per acre and I base my
valuation on the fact that a farm known as the
Harland
