& well Beloved William Caldwell Gent. Greeting:
We do by these Presents constitute and Appoint
you to be Surgeon to Our first (or Royal) Regiment of
Foot Comanded by Our most dearly beloved Son, His
Royal Highness Edward Duke of Kent K. G. Field
Marshal of Our Forces, with pay commencing on the
twenty fourth of January 1811. You are therefore
carefully and diligently to discharge the Duty of
Surgeon by doing and performing all and all manner
of things thereunto belonging. And you are to observe
& follow such orders and Directions from time to time,
as you shall receive from your Colonel or any other
your superior Officer, according to the Rules and
Discipline of War, Given at Our Court at Carlton
House, the thirtieth day of April 1811, in the fifty first
year of Our Reign.
