- Q.75 Could you explain to the Court, in your own words how and when you had the occasion, during the course of your duties, to come into contact with CQMS Boyer?
- A.75 On 5 April 1949, I received a telephone call from the APM HQ Quebec Command. I received instructions to carry out investigation in the case of CQMS Boyer. During the investigation was carried out in Quebec City I contacted the subject and at 1600 hours, on 6 April 1949 I placed him under close arrest and took him into custody.
- Q.76 When you say the subject, whom are you referring to?
- A.76 CQMS Boyer, Sir.
- Q.77 Where did you find CQMS Boyer?
- A.77 In a house, a rooming house, at 437 St. John St., Quebec, Que.
- Q.78 Did he surrender to you or did you apprehend him?
- A.78 I apprehended him.
- Q.79 After that, what did you do?
- A.79 I escorted him to Montreal and turned him over to be placed on custody at No. 25 COD on the same date.
- Q.80 I would ask you to repeat the date for the benefit of the Court?
- A.80 I turned him over to the Guard Room in 25 COD at 2330 hours on 6 Apr 49.
- Q.81 When did you apprehend him?
- A.81 On the same day, in Quebec City at 1600 hours.
- Q.82 How was he dressed?
- A.82 He was dressed in military uniform.
- Q.83 How did you identify CQMS Boyer?
- A.83 I knew him, Sir.
