I took 4th Lt. Brown
and Brown to the corner
where I had seen the
Amoured. We searched the
place and 4th Lt. Brown
picked up a fragment behind
a cement slab, a 2 lb can
of high explosive meat

I took it to Major
Prater, and he scratched
the letter C.F. on the
can. I produce this can
