General Speech

- (1) We all wish the reserves to be portioned and each man have a title given to him
- (2) We wish the right villages of the several Indian tribes to be ~~right~~ put in their name (as Kwi-kwa-su-ti-nuk) to be straightened out as they ought to have been in the beginning of the B. C. Government
- (3) We have made a list of each of our own villages. a list that we feel the B. C. G. ought to have got from our father's forty years ago. Then there would not have been the confusion in our Indian reserves that we have found now.
- (4) We ask the two governments to keep these lists of lands that they may reserve them for us untill this Commission settle our acreage. for this is where we wish to choose our portions.
- (5) We wish that 300 acres of the Indian reserve down the bay (known now as the Industrial School reserve) be reserved for all the people of the La-gult agencie who want to come and build there.
