Dear Sirs:-

At 1815 hours, 11 August 1946, aircraft CF - DGW, a Piper Cub J-3, piloted by student Miss Peggy Ram, crashed into a tree on the east end of the East-West Runway, on approaching the field for a landing. Miss Ram hit the tree with her right wing; this caused the airplane to do a flat spin which resulted in the crash. The aircraft landed on the left wheel in nose down attitude causing the lower section of the engine cowling to be pushed in, broke the propeller, buckled the engine mount, and the right wing straddled the fence.

The plane is dismantled and is being taken to the Cub factory in Hamilton. Miss Ram got out of the plane unaided and walked away unscratched.
