The whole sculpture is in Binny stone. The work was executed by Mr. John Steel, R. S. A., Her Majesty's sculptor in Scotland.

MOLSONS BANK,

situated on the corner of St. James and St. Peter Streets, is a magnificent building; built entirely of Ohio sandstone. It is three stories in height with a lofty basement. The style of architecture is Italian, and is highly ornamented.

BANK OF BRITISH NORTH AMERICA,

situated on St. James Street, near St. François Xavier, is built entirely of cut stone, and is of the composite style of architecture. The head office of this Bank is in London, England. It was established in 1836, and was incorporated by Royal charter in 1840.
