JUNE. - Cucumber vines, melons, squashes, &c., are often destroyed by a bug with a striped back. The insect is not new or strange; we ended their depredations by a very simple method and without expense. When the bugs or flies made their appearance we sprinkled the vines with chamber lye, two or three mornings in succession, or as long as we perceived them about. A moderately plentiful shower will not injure the vines, but rather give them a healthy stimulus. The remedy has been invariably successful. It appears as though the vexatious creatures were vexed with the odoriferous and other qualities of the lye shower, and either die or seek a continuance of existence by other means.
