**T**HIS First Class Hotel (the largest in Montreal) is situated on Great St. James street, in front of the French Cathedral, or Church Ville Marie, Notre Dame street, immediately adjacent to the Post Office, Place d'Armes and Banks; is only one minute's walk from the Grey or Black Nunneries, new Court House, Reading Rooms, Champ de Mars, (where the troops are reviewed,) Mechanic's Institute, Bonsecours Market and Fashionable Stores. The New Theatre Royal is directly in the rear of the House, and several of the best boxes in the Theatre are regularly reserved for the guests at St. Lawrence Hall.

St. Lawrence Hall has long been regarded as the most popular and fashionable Hotel in Montreal. It has been under the charge of its present proprietor over ten years. The building presents a front of some 300 feet on Great St. James street, with a depth of over 300 feet, and has over 300 apartments.

A large part of the Hall was engaged by Government for the Suite of His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales, during his visit to this City.
