Order'd, That the faid Bill, with the Amendments, be ingroffed, and the fame having been ingroffed accordingly, was read and agreed to by the House.

Order'd, That it be fent to His Majesty's Council; with a Message, that this House doth desire their Concurrence to the same.

Read a Second Time, the Bill intitled "An Act in further Amendment of the Act made in the Sixth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intitled An Act concerning Bail."

Bill concerning Bail read a fecond Time.

Bill for County

Charges presented.

Rosolv'd, That this House doth agree to the same. Order'd, That the said Bill be Ingrossed.

A Bill intitled "An Act in further Addition to an Act made in the Fifth Year of His Majesty's Reign, Intitled An Act for the raising Money by Presentment on the several Counties in this Province, for the defraying certain County Charges therein mentioned," was presented to the House and read.

Refolv'd, That this House doth agree to the same. Order'd, That the said Bill be ingross'd.

Then the House adjourn'd till'Tomorrow Morning Eleven o'Clock.

Wednesday, October 18, 1769,

Bill concerning Bail and Bill for County Charges passed. Read a Third Time and pass'd, the Bill in further Amendment of the Act concerning Bail, and the Bill in further addition to the Act for raising Money by Presentment on the several Counties, &c.

Order'd, That they be fent to His Majesty's Council; with a Message, that this House doth defire their Concurrence to the same.
