### The Telephone Rates

Editor Evening Telegram. Dear Sir .- A few days ago I reeived a printed notice reading as fol-

"NOTICE.

"Rates For Telephone Service. 'Commencing January 1st. 1926, the ollowing rates for Telephone Servicein St. John's will be effective:

Business Telephone Service (including Private Branch Exchange trunk lines) .. .. Residence, private line .. .. Residence, two-party line ...

'Residence, four-party line ... "Bills will be mailed to subscribers during the first week of January and first week of July in each year, cov-

"A discount of 20 per cent, will be allowed on the above rates if payment is made at the Company's office before

"The accidental omission to mail a the mail delivery, etc., before the dates specified, will not entitle the subscriber to any discount after these

"Should a subscriber not receive his bill for telephone service before say the 10th inst, he should phone or call

I am a subscriber to the Telephone service supplied this city and have een for a number of years past. I presume a similar notice has been re ceived by every person, firm or Com-

pany that uses the telephone service I dislike the idea of an increase in cost of the 'phones and the suggestion that the Avalon Telephone Co., Ltd., has a right to increase the cost of the service whenever they feel disposed to do so, and I resent the manner in municated to telephone subscribers. think the community generally and the business community particular! should not allow this high-handed conduct of the Telephone Co. to page without challenge. On all sides one in the matter. I propose to appeal to all parties interested in having tale phone service to wake up and real'z what the present action of the Telephone Co. means and what it may mean in the future. Three questions arise for consideration:

1. Has the Telephone Co. the right to increase the rates as proposed' 2. If they have a right, is there any imit to the increase in rates that they may make from time to

3. If they have the right to make such increase, what is the most effective way for Telephone subscribers to fight them?

If we remain passive and allow ourselves to be placed at the mercy of the Telephone Co. what is there to prevent the rates being further raised on us next year, and so on in each succeeding year?

I would suggest that a meeting of Telephone Subscribers be held without delay for the purpose of organizing to protect ourselves against the apparently extortionate demands of the Telephone Co. I use the expression "apparently extortionate demands" advisedly, for the notice above referred to does not attempt to suggest any reason for the increased rates, and I presume if there was a justifiable reason that the Company would be only too glad to have informed subscrib-

Let us first ascertain what is the nature of the franchise granted to this Company; secondly let us ascertain if that franchise gives the Company the right to fix the rates for service at whatever figure they please; thirdly let us call upon the Government to create a permanent Public Utilities Board or Commission with jurisdiction enabling it to curb unreasonable or extortionate demands from the Company; and fourthly, if nothing else can be done, let us decide in a body to relinquish the Telephone Service and have the instruments removed from our respective

I do not intend to let this matter rest here and I hope to have the cooperation of all Telephone Subscribers in my efforts to protect ourselves against the Company.
