

PITTSBURGER WHO WENT INTO POLITICS IN ENGLAND, IS ELECTED TO PARLIAMENT

Defeated Two Years Ago in the Contest for the Constituency of Crewe, He Makes the Race Again and Wins

Pittsburgh, Penn., Aug. 3.—News has reached this city that Ernest Crawshaw, who some years ago wooed fortune in the mines of the far West and a prominent society life in Pittsburgh, has just been elected to the British parliament for the constituency of Crewe, one of the most important in England.

Mr. Crawshaw has a large circle of relatives and friends in Pittsburgh, and many years ago married Miss Anna McKay, daughter of James McKay. When he came to Pittsburgh he was for a time in business here, and he later went west prospecting and for long and discouraging period failed to discover "pay dirt."

Two years ago he stood for election to the British house of commons for the constituency of the city of Crewe. He not only was well acquainted with methods of English elections, but had absorbed something of the "cuteness" of American methods.

He made a canvass in that Liberal district which was a surprise to both Liberals and Conservatives, and failed of election by a bare Liberal majority, polling an unprecedented Conservative vote.

DARROW UNDER BATH DENIES BRIBERY CHARGES

Attorney on Witness Stand Says He Paid Out No Money for Such Purposes

He Admits Giving Checks to Franklin, But Declares They Were Earned Legitimately

Relates Conversations With Wife of Ortie McManigal and Other Witnesses

Chicago, Ill., Aug. 4.—Clarence S. Darrow, who is on trial for the alleged bribery of jurors in the McNamara trial, went on the witness stand shortly after 4 o'clock this afternoon.

Just before adjournment Darrow testified emphatically that he gave no \$10,000 check to Bert Franklin on October 6. He stated that he did not give him a \$10,000 check, just as he gave him checks before and after that date in the regular course of business for legitimate purposes.

Franklin testified that Darrow gave him a check on October 6, following a conversation October 5 about a jury bribery, and that he used the money gotten on his check in the payment of the \$100 to juror Robert Bain.

In answer to questions by Earl Rogers, his chief counsel, Darrow named the \$100 as the amount of money he had been concerned, either as counsel or witness, in the McNamara trial, and his position he held.

Cite Mrs. McManigal's Visit His story relating to the bribery began with the visit to him at his home in Chicago of Mrs. Ortie McManigal and George Behm, uncle of McManigal, in June of 1911.

Mrs. McManigal did not believe the statements given out by the Burns people of what her husband had confessed to. She thought if McManigal had made them it was done under compulsion and untrue.

The Burns people, she said, had offered her money, and her expenses if she would go to California and support her husband in his 203 1/2th street office. Darrow detailed how he arranged for Mrs. McManigal to go to Los Angeles.

He had probably a dozen men working under him. His detailed testimony was taken on an unsworn oath of the nature in which he would be asked to testify.

He said he would be \$65 years old next August 12, that he had been in the law for 25 years to employ a younger man for the McNamara defense, but the officers of the American Federation of Labor, many of whom were his close personal friends, insisted that he undertake the defense. It was finally induced by them to become chief counsel.

Point Called by Defense. The defense made an important victory after a long argument today, in gaining the consent of District Attorney Rogers to let Darrow, under the defendant copies of all letters and telegrams he has in his possession pertaining to the McNamara trial, in the course of which Rogers put several witnesses on the stand, including the defendant's attorney, and Assistant District Attorney Ford.

Jury 14. A Levitt was finally directed to sit at the table of the thirteenth juror, A. M. Balesky, took his place as a juror today. This is the first time in the McNamara trial in which a thirteenth juror has filled a vacancy in the jury caused by death of a juror.
