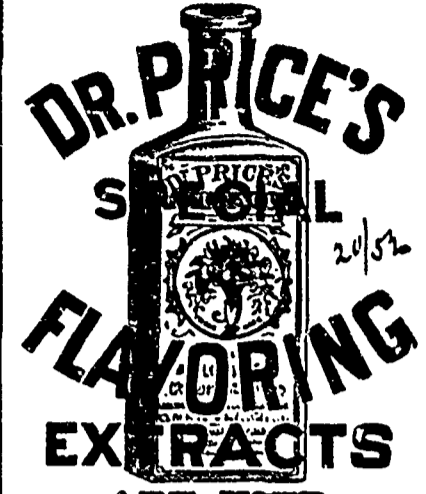

**Scientific and Useful.**

A LITTLE lemon juice in water with no sugar is very efficient in quenching thirst.

ALWAYS iron brown linen, calicoes, cambrics and lawns on the wrong side.

WHEN you hang a piece of meat no not sprinkle salt over it, because salt draws the juice out.

BOIL your cream for coffee, and see if the coffee will not taste better, as well as keep hot longer.

By rubbing with a damp flannel dipped in the best whiting, the brown discoloration may be taken off cups in which custards have been baked.

POP-OVERS.—One egg, one pint milk, one pint flour, not quite half teaspoonful of salt, beat thoroughly. Must be baked in hot oven. Delicious for breakfast.

FAINTING.—Place the patient on the back with the head lower than the body, if convenient. Give plenty of air by fanning; dash cold water in the face; smell of hartshorn or camphor. Give ammonia or spirits.

PICKLES are unhealthy as articles of food and often cause acute dyspepsia. Cucumbers prepared with salt and vinegar are next to impossible of digestion.

SAUCE FOR BOILED FISH.—Take two tablespoonfuls of the water which has been used in boiling the fish, and put it in a stew pan, add an onion and a tablespoonful of walnut catsup. Let it stand and simmer for a quarter of an hour. Add a pint of good veal gravy, and strain and thicken with butter and flour.

FURNITURE POLISH.—Take of Castile soap, white wax, and beeswax, one oz. of each, shave these into half a pint of turpentine in jar or bowl, stand this in a cool oven for some hours, and, when dissolved, add half a pint of cold soft water, shake well before using. All furniture should be washed with vinegar and water, (about half a pint of vinegar to a quart of water) polish well with soft linen, then apply this polish, which will be found fully to repay all trouble. For removing dust from the ornamental work of furniture nothing is better than a goose wing, which is light and yet strong. I may add to those girls who love to see their surroundings in perfect order, they will fully acknowledge that, although the recipe is so simple, it is well worthy of a place in the storeroom.

CARE OF CLOTHES.—Spots of grease may be removed from coloured silks by putting on them raw starch made into a paste with water. Dust is best removed from silk by a soft flannel, from velvet with a brush made especially for that purpose. If hats and bonnets when taken from the head are brushed and put away in boxes and covered up, instead of being laid down anywhere, they will last fresh a long time. Shawls and all articles that may be folded should be folded when taken from the person, in their original creases, and laid away. Cloaks should be hung up in place, gloves pulled out lengthwise, wrapped in tissue paper and laid away; laces smoothed out nicely and folded, if requisite, so that they will come out of the box new and fresh when needed again. A strip of old black broadcloth four or five inches wide, rolled up tightly and sewed to keep the roll in place, is better than a sponge or cloth for cleaning black or dark-coloured clothes. Whatever lint comes from it in rubbing is black, and does not show.

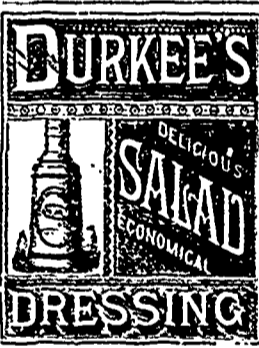
