

CREAM CRACKERS.—Sift a teaspoonful of baking powder in one quart of flour, also a large pinch of salt and five tablespoonfuls of sugar; rub in four tablespoonfuls of butter (cold), and five beaten eggs, mix into smooth dough, and knead rapidly for a few minutes, cover with a damp towel for fifteen minutes, then roll out thin, cut with round cutter. When all cut drop them a few at a time in a large pot of boiling water. When they appear at the surface, and curl at edges, take them up with a skimmer and drop in a pan of cold water. Then lay them on greased tins, and bake in a hot oven fifteen minutes.

CREAM OF CELERY SOUP.—Take one head celery cut in small pieces and boiled in one pint white stock; add one slice onion, one half blade mace and four peppercorns. Boil one hour. Rub through a sieve. Add one pint more white stock, boil, then add one pint cream. Cook one tablespponful of butter and one of flour together, and add to the soup. This soup stock was made originally from a knuckle of veal. Water may be used instead, if preferred. Make the addition of stock while rubbing the cooked celery through the sieve to assist the process. Let the mixture boil, and add the butter and flour cooked together.
