AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 29, REVISED STATUTES, "OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION."

(Passed the 15th day of April, A. D. 1890.)

Be it enacted by the Governor, Council, and Assembly, as follows

Notwithstanding anything contained in section 27, subsection 5 of chapter 29, Revised Statutes, "Of Public Instruction," be lawful for Trustees of Schools and Boards of School Commissioners in the City of Halifax, and in incorpo ated towns, with the approval of the Council of Public Instruction, to establish special departments for children under five years of age.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 30 OF THE ACTS OF 1889. ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 29, REVISED STATUTES, "OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION."

(Passed the 15th day of April, A. D. 1890.)

Be it enacted by the Governor, Council and Assembly, as follows:

Chapter 30 of the Acts of 1889 is hereby amended by the addition of the following words: "In case the owner or owners of any land selected for a school site shall refuse or unduly delay to appoint the pointed by the Warden of the municipality in which said school site is situated, on the written application of the Inspector of Reading."
