HOW MARBLES ARE MADE.

Nearly all the agate marbles used in America, says an exchange, are made at Oberstein, Germany, from the refuse of the many agate quarries in that part of the Fatherland. The stone is broken up by experts with a small hammer. The little cubes thus formed are shoveled up and thrown into a small mill, with what is called a bedstone, formed with concentric furrows or grooves. Above the bedstone is a wooden block with a level face upon its lower surface. This is made to revolve with great rapidity, water being thrown on the bedstone while the process of rounding is taking place. It takes about fifteen minutes to round the marbles to the proper shape, and one mill working eight hours a day can turn out nearly 200,000 marbles in a week. Fine marbles are made in this country, but they are not equal to the German product.
