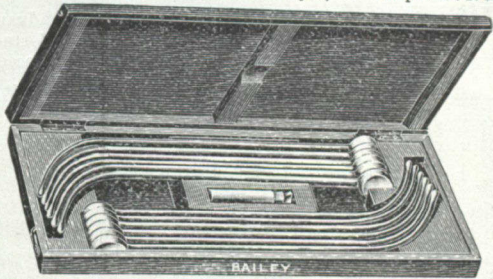

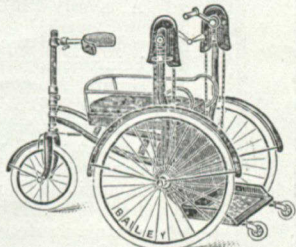

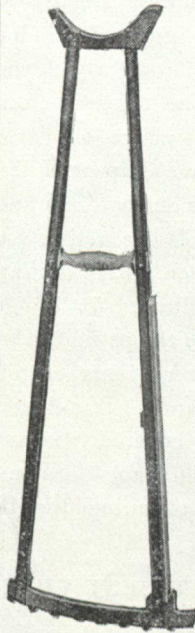

# The Weldon "Auto-Motive" Crutch.

FOR LOCOMOTION WITHOUT EXERTION.



Owing to the unique construction of the base, the user is propelled by gravitation without any exertion beyond resting the weight of the body on the handles.

In proceeding down hill it is only necessary to reverse the crutches, which then act as a natural brake.

But the feature of the "Weldon Auto-motive" is the anatomically correct position of the head, which conforms to the oblique direction of the axilla.

At the same time the segmental bases are parallel to each other and to the line of progression. Thus all risk of "crutch paralysis" is entirely eliminated, there being no irritation of the brachial plexus, as is common to all crutches with parallel heads.
