MESSAGE FROM THE HIGH COMMISSIONER



His Excellency the High Commissioner for Canada, Raymond C. Anderson.

A significant step in Canadian-Australian trade relations is taking place this year in Perth, with the establishment of a Consulate General. This is the first significant change in our representation since the appointment of Canada's first High Commissioner to Australia, over forty years ago. The establishment of a Consulate General in the Western Australian Capital is indicative of an expanding relationship between out two countries, and indicative of the importance that Canada places on further developing that mutually beneficial relationship.

There is much we can share in knowledge and experience in many fields of endeavour — in resource development, high technology, satellite communication, agriculture, transport and cultural development.

I am confident that the community of Western Australia in the broadest interpretation of the word will welcome the opening of the Consultate General, and will make full use of the services it will provide.
