Note by the Secretary-General

Duration and venue of the session

1. The forty-seventh session of the Commission on Human Rights will be held at the United Nations Office at Geneva from 28 January to 8 March 1991. The first meeting will be convened at 11 a.m. Monday, 28 January 1991.

Provisional agenda

2. The provisional agenda, prepared in accordance with rule 5 of the rules of procedure of the functional commissions of the Economic and Social Council, is reproduced below.

Pre-sessional working groups

3. The forty-seventh session of the Commission is expected to be preceded by meetings of four groups in connection with the following items:

(a) Item 12 (b): Working Group on Situations, composed of five members of the Commission, to examine situations referred to the Commission by the Sub-Commission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities under Economic and Social Council resolution 1503 (XLVIII) of 27 May 1970 (Commission resolution 1990/55, Council resolution 1990/41) is scheduled to meet from 21 to 25 January 1991;

(b) Item 14: an open-ended working group established to examine, revise and simplify the draft body of principles and guarantees for the protection of mentally-ill persons and for the improvement of mental health care (Commission resolution 1990/38, Economic and Social Council resolution 1990/37) is scheduled to meet from 29 October to 9 November 1990;
