## January 1, 1996

There will be another tariff cut. This is the final deadline for Canada and the U.S. to agree on new trade remedy rules. Productionbased duty waivers for production in the auto industry will end.

January 1, 1997

Another tariff reduction.

January 1, 1998

Tariffs will have ended on remaining goods:

Most agricultural products

Steel

Textiles and apparel

**Appliances** 

Softwood plywood

Beef

Pleasure craft

Railcars

Tires

The snapback provisions on vegetables and fresh fruits will remain for another decade.
