

Article 22

Final Provisions

This Treaty shall enter into force on the day after the date of deposit of the ratification instruments with the Secretary-General of the United Nations. It shall remain in force for a period of ten years from the date of its entry into force. It shall be subject to renewal for successive periods of ten years each, unless the two Parties notify the Secretary-General of their intention to terminate it in writing at least six months before the expiration of the current period.

On the day of the deposit of the ratification instruments, the Parties shall deposit with the Secretary-General of the United Nations a copy of the text of the Treaty in the English, French, and Spanish languages. All three texts shall be equally authentic.

The Treaty shall be subject to ratification by the Parties. The ratification instruments shall be deposited with the Secretary-General of the United Nations. The Treaty shall enter into force on the day after the date of deposit of the ratification instruments with the Secretary-General of the United Nations. It shall remain in force for a period of ten years from the date of its entry into force.
