The Canadian Ambassador presents his compliments to the Secretary of State and has the honour to refer to the Department's note of September 25, 1950, concerning certain temporary modifications in the Pacific Ocean Weather Station Programme established by the agreement of June 1950\* between the Canadian and the United States Governments.

In signifying its understanding of the proposed temporary modifications in the Pacific Ocean Weather Station Programme, the Canadian Government requests that the temporary requirement of Station "U" be reviewed from time to time by appropriate officials of the two Governments, with a view to activating Sation "O" at the earliest possible date, in accordance with the agreement for the establishment and operation of the Pacific Ocean Weather Station Programme.
