

- 2) If it is decided at any time in the future by either Government, following consideration by the Permanent Joint Board on Defence as provided above, that the facilities are no longer necessary for mutual defense purposes, the land together with any immovable facilities on it will, on twelve months' notice, revert to the use of the Canadian Government.
- 3) Any movable property placed on the land by the United States may be removed by the United States at any time prior to the evacuation of the property by U.S. Forces, or within a reasonable time thereafter.
- 4) Arrangements respecting such technical matters as frequencies and powers and the location, marking and lighting of antenna masts will be coordinated with the Royal Canadian Air Force and with the Department of Transport of Canada and will be subject to the approval of the Department of Transport.

If the foregoing is acceptable to your Government this note and your reply shall be regarded as constituting an agreement having immediate effect from the date of your reply.

ANNEX

- 1) 640 acres in the West Bay area for the construction of a transmitter station. The coordinates of the center of the site are North 48° 37' 05" West 58° 59' 06".
- 2) 380 acres in the Jerry's Nose area for the construction of a receiver station. The coordinates of the center of the site are North 48° 31' 08" West 58° 56' 0".
- 3) An area 200 feet by 200 feet in the Romaines, Newfoundland, area and access road thereto for the construction of an unattended microwave relay station. The coordinates of the center of the site are North 48° 33' 46" West 58° 41' 4". The center of the site may be varied within a circle of a one-quarter mile radius.
