Canada has a long history of development cooperation and assistance in Asia, in keeping with our foreign policy objectives for prosperity, security and the projection of Canadian values such as respect for human rights and democratic development. Since 1968, Canada has disbursed a total of C \$46 billion to developing nations around the world. Canada contributes about 5.5 per cent of the Asian Development Bank's annual capital, and was one of its founding members.
