International Law

The Legal Affairs Branch is the principal source of advice to the Government of Canada on its rights and obligations under a wide range of complex international law issues. Its principal functions include: advocacy on behalf of Canada in international litigation (e.g., before World Trade Organization and North American Free Trade Agreement tribunals and before the International Court of Justice); policy management and development of legal issues; negotiation of international agreements; and services to the public, such as authentication of documents and treaty registration.
