

The Order being read for the House to resolve itself again into Committee of Ways and Means;

Mr. Dunning moved,—That Mr. Speaker do now leave the Chair.

And the question being put on the said motion; it was agreed to.

The House accordingly resolved itself again into Committee of Ways and Means.

*(In the Committee)*

The following Resolution was adopted:—

Resolved, That towards making good the Supply granted to His Majesty on account of certain expenses of the Public Service for the fiscal years ending the 31st March, 1936, and the 31st March, 1937, respectfully, the sum of \$267,621,461.71 be granted out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Canada.

Resolution to be reported.

By leave of the House the said Resolution was reported, read the second time and concurred in.

Mr. Dunning then, by leave of the House, presented a Bill, No. 115, An Act for granting to His Majesty certain sums of money for the public service of the financial years ending respectively the 31st March, 1936, and the 31st March, 1937, which was read the first time.

By leave of the House, the said Bill was read the second time, considered in Committee of the Whole, reported without amendment, read the third time and passed.

A Message was received from the Senate informing this House that the Senate had passed the following Bill:—

An Act for the relief of Agnes Hannah Wright.

An Act for the relief of Margery Brunhilde Morphy Dunton.

An Act for the relief of Mania Leizeron Oberman.
