SUBSIDIZING OF GOLD MINING OPERATORS

Question No. 1,122—**Mr. Lambert (Bellechasse):**

Does the federal government in any way subsidize gold mining operators and, if so (a) how much was paid for this purpose during the last fiscal year (b) to what companies were these payments made (c) how much was paid to each of them?

Hon. J. J. Greene (Minister of Energy, Mines and Resources): Financial assistance is given to operators of gold mines in Canada under the provisions of the Emergency Gold Mining Assistance Act. (a) The total assistance payable under the Act to gold mine operators with respect to the calendar year 1967 amounted to \$15,152,976; (b) and (c) The amounts payable for the year 1967 to each operator was as follows:
