The question being put on the motion, it was— Resolved in the affirmative.

The Bill was then read the third time.

The question was put whether this Bill shall pass. It was resolved in the affirmative.

Ordered, That a Message be sent to the House of Commons to acquaint that House that the Senate have passed this Bill, without amendment.

The Order of the Day being called for the second reading of the Bill (B), intituled: "An Act to confirm an Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of the Province of New Brunswick respecting Indian Reserves", it was—

Ordered, That it be postponed until to-morrow.

The Order of the Day being called to resume the adjourned debate on the motion of the Honourable Senator Connolly (Ottawa West), seconded by the Honourable Senator Connolly (Halifax North), for the third reading of Bill (Y-7), intituled: "An Act to amend the Government Property Traffic Act", and the proposed amendment by the Honourable Senator Pouliot, seconded by the Honourable Senator Croll, that the Bill be not now read a third time but that it be referred back to the Standing Committee on Transport and Communications to complete the evidence relating to the Senate property outside the Parliament Building (Central Block), it was—

Ordered, That it be postponed until to-morrow.

The Senate adjourned.
