FIFTH SEDERUNT.

At Ottawa and within St. Andrew's Church there, Friday the thirteenth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine years:—

Which day the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in Canada met pursuant to adjournment, and was constituted by the Moderator.

Prayer was offered up by the Rev. Dr. McGregor. The Minutes of the Third and Fourth Sederunts were read and sustained.

Dr. Waters, Clerk of the Committee on Business, presented and read a report. Said Report was received and, after amendment, was adopted as to the order of busines for this Diet.

It was moved by Dr. Topp, duly seconded and passed unanimously, That the Committee on Bills and Overtures be instructed to prepare a docket of the business before the Assembly, arranged for each day, to be presented to the Assembly to-morrow morning and, if approved by the Assembly, to be printed for the information of the members.

It was further moved by Mr. W. B. McMurrich, seconded by Mr. D. J. Macdonnell and passed unanimously, That the names of Commissioners on the various Committees, appointed by the Assembly, be printed and distributed.
