

entitled, 'An Act for granting to His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, to and for the uses of this Province, the like Duties on Goods and Merchandize brought into this Province from the United States of America as are now paid on Goods and Merchandize imported from Great Britain, and other places,' and to provide more effectually for the Collection and Payment of Duties on Goods and Merchandize coming from the United States of America into this Province; and also to establish a fund for the erection and repairing of Light Houses," be, and the same are hereby repealed.

II. *And be it Enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That it shall and may be lawful for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or person administering the Government of this Province, by commission under his hand and seal at arms, to nominate and appoint one or more Collector or Collectors at the Ports of Entry and Clearance, now or hereafter to be established.

III. *And be it further Enacted by the authority aforesaid,* that each and every Collector shall give security, by way of recognizance or obligation, to His Majesty, with two sureties in five hundred pounds each, and himself in one thousand pounds, for the due performance of his office.

IV. *And be it further Enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the said Collectors shall, and they are hereby authorized to appoint one or more Deputy or Deputies; and that the said Collectors and Deputies shall have power and authority, and they are hereby required to seize and secure any Vessel, Boat, Raft, or Carriage, Goods, Wares, or Merchandize, which shall be liable to seizure, under the authority of this Act, or under any other law of this Province, as well without as within their respective districts.

V. *And be it further Enacted by the authority aforesaid,*
