inform him when the time allowed for reading it will expire, and if he does not apply for the same the day it is returned, (provided it be duly returned,) the Librarian may deliver it to another subscriber.

No person shall exchange Books twice in the same day. If any proprietor or subscriber, shall lend a Library Book, or receive one from any other person, than the Librarian, he shall forfeit and be deprived the use of the Library, until the forfeit is paid.

Any Book torn or injured in the hands of a proprietor or subscriber, becomes his, and must be paid for double the value with that of the set to which it belongs; and it is incumbent on every person to take care that the Book is in good order before he takes it out, as he will be deprived the use of the library until this rule is complied with—and any subscriber finding a Book imperfect, is requested to give the Librarian immediate notice.
