## THE SENATE OF CANADA

## BILL S8.

An Act for the relief of Elizabeth Temple Jamieson Grier.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Elizabeth Temple Jamieson Grier, residing at the city of Montreal, in the province of Quebec, wife of Eldon Lennox Brockwill Grier, who is domiciled in Canada and residing at the said city, has by her petition alleged that they were married on the eighteenth day of October, A.D. 1941, at the said city, she then being Elizabeth Temple Jamieson, a spinster; and whereas by her petition she has prayed that, because of his adultery since then, their marriage be dissolved; and whereas the said marriage and adultery have been proved by evidence adduced and it is expedient that the prayer of her petition be granted: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Marriage dissolved.

1. The said marriage between Elizabeth Temple Jamieson 15 and Eldon Lennox Brockwill Grier, her husband, is hereby dissolved, and shall be henceforth null and void to all intents and purposes whatsoever.

Right to marry again.

2. The said Elizabeth Temple Jamieson may at any time hereafter marry any man whom she might lawfully marry 20 if the said marriage with the said Eldon Lennox Brockwill Grier had not been solemnized.
