Selecting Seed. Hens Need Fresh Air

Selecting seed for planting is one of the most, if not the most, essential starting points in spring work on the farm and in the garden.

For example, take a bushel of corn from the bin, not sorted, shell it and plant it as it runs; then select a bushel of ears which possess all the requirements of perfection in that special variety.

Beets, turnips, carrots, onions and cabbage that are to produce the next crop of seed should be carefully selected as to size and shape.

When to Sow Vegetable Seeds. Seeds of the hardiest vegetables may be sown as soon as the ground is entirely free from frost and can be put in proper condition.
