## ELECTRIC TRACTION FOR TUNNEL.

The announcement has been given out by the Grand Trunk Railway System that arrangements have been made for the adoption of electric traction in the St. Clair Tunnel.

The contract for which has been awarded to the Westinghouse Electric and Manufacturing Co., the work to be started at once and brought to completion as quickly as possible. The tunnel, which is 2,000 feet long, will be used for the transportation of coal and other goods. The electric traction system will be operated by a central power house, and the cost of the project is estimated at \$1,000,000.

The number of immigrant arrivals in Ontario during 1905 was 25,226 men, women and children. The figures for 1904 showed 18,221 persons, so that 1905 exceeded the previous year by 6,005 immigrants.

The figures for last year are: January, 1,906, 2,730; February, 2,200; March, 2,511; April, 2,511; May, 2,711; June, 2,333; July, 2,442; August, 2,544; September, 1,912; October, 2,554; November, 1,000; December, 674; total, 25,226.

About fifty immigrants of the steamship Dominion arrived last night. Only a few of them will be sent out on farms.
