Many of the tribunals are not greatly in favor of the decision of the provincial registrar to allot forty cases a day, beginning next Monday, A few of the local boards find that it takes them until after five o'clock to deal with the twenty-five cases now set down for decision.

To speed up the machinery of the M.S.A. the registrar has decided to start the work of the appeal boards before the local tribunals have finished their work, and it is likely that early next week several such boards in various sections of the city will be
