The demand for the wider use of school buildings is growing in Canada, and we read that the South Ottawa Municipal League is appealing to the public school board for the use of the classrooms of the schools in the evenings, to be used as community centres.

We hear very little now about National Service. Mr. Bennett has come and gone, and those who are willing to fill out the National Service cards are doing or have done so. And there the matter rests. Public interest now begins to centre in the session of parliament which opens in Ottawa next week.

The people of Berlin, Ontario, changed its name to Kitchener. Hon. Mr. Blomfield, Sir Robert Borden's Nationalist colleague, has put Berlin on the postal maps again, reversing the action taken by his predecessor.

The British war loan is popular. One of the amazing things about Britain is her financial strength. She is, indeed, as the prime minister says, "a tower in the deep" for the Allied powers.

The Standard gravely argues that to be a member of the government of Canada a man should be a Conservative. Then why does not Sir Robert Borden dismiss his Nationalist colleagues?
