That the Clerical Secretary, inasmuch as he derives a portion of his salary for managing the Fund known as the Rectory Lands Fund, be requested to furnish to each Rector, at least one week previous to Easter Monday in each year, a statement in detail of the amount invested from the sale of the lands of the Rectory, showing how invested, at what rate of interest, at what dates the interest is payable, and what arrears have accrued during the past year.

Also that the Secretary be directed to notify all mortgagors of the interest or principal falling due, at least one week previous to the date of its becoming due; and also that the interest be paid to the Rectors entitled to it, half yearly, as it may be received.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS.

It was moved by W. Ellis, seconded by the Rev. Canon Mulock,

That hereafter it be the rule of this Synod to meet for business at 9:30 a.m. each business day, and that the mid-day adjournment for luncheon do not exceed one hour and a half; and that evening sessions be held each alternate evening until the business of the Session be closed.—
Carried.

The Rev. C. Forest moved, seconded by the Rev. Dr. Boswell,

1. That the election and appointment of the Mission Board take place on the first business day of the Session.

2. And that section No. 5, sub-section 5 of order of proceedings be amended by striking out "on second morning of the Synod the election of Provincial Delegates," and inserting "the election of delegates to Provincial Synod shall be the first order on the third day, if the Session shall last so long, or the last business transacted if the Session be of shorter duration."

The first part of the resolution was put and carried. The second part was put and carried. The motion was then put as a whole and *carried.*

It being the hour of 1 o'clock, the Synod adjourned until 3 P.M.
