#### Grapes Grow Out Of Doors In B. C.

Victoria, Nov. 5.—Grapes as fine and luscious as those of Portugal are now being grown out of doors on Vancouver Island. Schaper of Victoria, the pioneer of grape growing here, has been exhibiting specimens of the classic fruit produced in this city.

The vines were originally imported by Mr. Schaper from Portugal and Switzerland. Brown grapes are the Portuguese variety, while the "white sweet water" are of Swiss origin. Mr. Schaper says that grapes can be produced here quite equal to those of the countries mentioned. As he desires to encourage the cultivation of the vine in this province, he is supplying, free of charge, cuttings from his vines to anyone who may apply for them.

These grapes are good eating ones, make excellent port wine, "white wine," or grape juice, and are particularly suitable for the making of jellies. Many prizes have been awarded at exhibitions for grapes grown from cuttings supplied by Mr. Schaper.
