MORNING NEWS OVER THE WIRES

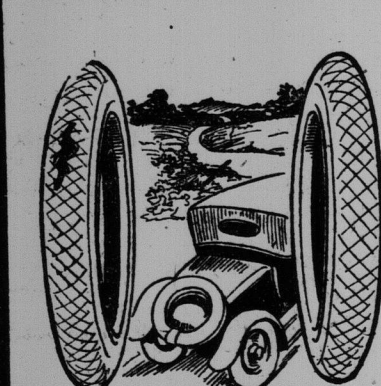

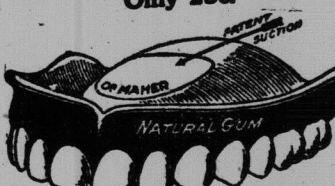
